Study on the health and driving behaviours of lorry drivers

- A study conducted by an interdisciplinary team of researchers
 - Patricia Delhomme, Université Gustave Eiffel
 Pr Loïc Josseran, Hôpital de Garches Université
 Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines
- A field study
 - 515 drivers of 17 different nationalities, of whom 50% were French
- An awareness-raising campaign in partnership with the Carcept Prev Foundation - 1/06
 - At three rest areas in the VINCI Autoroutes network
 - Prevention messages from the study
 - Various workshops with sleep specialists, nutritionists, relaxation therapists, sports therapists







Study on the health and driving behaviours of lorry drivers

Main lessons

- Lorry drivers have plenty of experience
- A real risk of accident due to lack of attention and sleep
 - 1 in 2 has ever ridden on rumble strips through distraction, drowsiness, or wanting to be guided
- Awareness of the risk for road crews on motorways
 - 1st risk factor identified : when there is another lorry passing them while they are trying to change lanes to avoid a crew vehicle on the side of the road
- Professionals who know they could do more to be healthy...
 - 73% of them therefore carry extra weight
 - Less than one third of lorry drivers say they make sure to exercise
 - Above average tobacco consumption




Among those drivers who nearly had an accident in the last year
