A history of interoperability

- '97 Council resolution on ITS, incl. interoperable EFC
- '97 Amsterdam conference on international EFC interoperability
 - No investments planned by concessionnaires
 - No business case for international tolling for concessionnaires
- '02 Stockholm Group established
- '04 directive 2004/52
- '04 '09 Long process of definition of EETS
 - Comité Télépéage
 - Cesare Projects
 - Road Platform
 - Stockholm Group
- 8 October 2009 decision 2009/750/EC came into force

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Issues encountered and Choices made

- Cesare projects by ASECAP & Stockholm Grp to define organisation
- Only Galileo from '07 \rightarrow let market decide
- TC user contract \rightarrow EETS Provider in the middle
- No/limited vehicle parameters \rightarrow EU set + subsidiarity
- EETS SP responsible for OBU \rightarrow in future: car industry + smartcard?
- Open interface for VAS "shall" → "should"
- Thin or thick OBU ? → in principle both allowed
- International enforcement \rightarrow not solved
- Compliance checking for non-real-time → not covered yet
- Much to be defined and realised still, so questions about time table → EC declaration for 18 months evaluation
